Nothing is more important to us than our Student's, Teacher's & Parent's safety. Please help us in making our class a safe environment for all.

RARE Learning Staff follows all the required health and safety guidelines and are recommended to wear masks. All RARE Learning staff are vaccinated. These policies are subject to change as we continue to get updates from the locations.

For RARE students, as per all the location guidelines, masks are not required. However, if parents wish for their child to wear a mask they are welcome to do so with the understanding that the mask will have to be removed during snack time.

For Parents entering our classroom, we kindly request & recommend that you have a mask on during drop off and pick up. However, you are welcome to follow the most current center mask guidelines outside our classroom. As and when CDC & State guidelines get updated, our saftey policies will too.

We recommend that you sign in your child at our sign in table either at the entrance to the classroom or outside the classroom based on each location's guidelines and allow the child to enter the main classroom area on their own to maintain adequate social distance. Parents, please make a restroom stop before dropping your child to class in order to help us maintain health and safety in class.

At pick up time we will have the children ready and will dismiss one by one as parents sign them out on our sign in/out sheet. Please make sure to fill ALL the information that is needed on the sheet. All adults must maintain an adequate distance inside & outside the classroom at drop off and pick up time in order to maintain safety guidelines. All surfaces, toys, stationary, mats, tables/chairs will be sanitized periodically. Hand sanitizer also be used in class periodically.

We ask that you do not enter the class if you have been exposed to someone with Covid-19, or If you have returned from a country with a CDC Travel alert in the past 14 days or are currently experiencing any flu-like symptoms like fever, nausea/vomiting, cough, sore throat or have difficulty breathing.

If your child exhibits any of these symptoms as well, please keep them home for that day. If your child is seen by a doctor due to their symptoms, please bring a doctor's note to class indicating that they are able to return to school safely. This will ensure the safety of all others in class. Missed classes will follow our policy as outlined in this parent handbook that you are required to read & acknowledge at the time of registration.
